WHEREAS, RLI Surety Insurance Company issued a surety bond in the amount of EIGHT THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$8,000.00) for the payment of liquor and other taxes to PB & L Enterprises Inc. dba Vieux Carre.

WHEREAS, the Principal failed to pay taxes in the amount of ELEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY NINE AND 99/100 DOLLARS (\$11,679.99) for the taxing period of October 2011 through July 2012; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk-Treasurer's Office has made every possible effort to collect the taxes due from the Principal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Huntsville, Alabama, that the City Attorney's Office is hereby authorized, requested, and directed to seek a forfeiture of the surety bond issued by RLI Surety Insurance Company; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Huntsville, Alabama, that the Mayor, upon payment by RLI Surety Insurance Company and in accordance with its bond, is hereby authorized, requested, and directed to execute a release and assignment agreement substantially in words and figures as Attachment "A", an executed copy of said document being permanently kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Huntsville, Alabama.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that the undersigned, for the sole consideration of EIGHT THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$8,000.00) to be paid by RLI Surety Insurance Company from the bond of PB & L Enterprises Inc. dba Vieux Carre (Bond Number RSB332812), to the City of Huntsville, Alabama, releases and discharges RLI Surety Insurance Company from the obligation of the bond to the extent of EIGHT THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$8,000.00) received for the taxing period of October 2011 through July 2012.

In further consideration of payment of EIGHT THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$8,000.00) of the above noted bond, the City of Huntsville, Alabama, hereby assigns to RLI Surety Insurance Company any claim the City of Huntsville, Alabama, may have against PB & L Enterprises Inc. dba Vieux Carre for delinquent or deficient taxes or license fees to the extent of the remitted amount of EIGHT THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$8,000.00) for the taxing period of October 2011 through July 2012. The City of Huntsville, Alabama, retains any claim it may have against PB & L Enterprises Inc. dba Vieux Carre for delinquent or deficient taxes or license fees greater than the amount EIGHT THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$8,000.00) received from RLI Surety Insurance Company for the taxing period of October 2011 through July 2012.
