**WHEREAS**, the City Council and Mayor of the City of Huntsville, Alabama, are apprised that National Baptist Laymen Junior Laymen Director Alvin Moore was inducted into the Alabama High School 2014 Hall of Fame; and,

**WHEREAS**, Alvin will be recognized during the Mid-Winter Board Meeting of the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc., held in "*The Magic City*" of Birmingham, Alabama at the Birmingham-Jefferson Convention Complex on January 20 - 23, 2014; and,

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Julius R. Scruggs was elected President of the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc., September 10, 2009, during the 129th Annual Session held in Memphis, Tennessee. Dr. Scruggs served as the Vice President-At-Large under the Shaw administration. Dr. Scruggs is also the Pastor of the First Missionary Baptist in Huntsville, Alabama; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Mid-Winter Board Meeting is one of two major business meetings of the Convention. Held annually during the month of January, this meeting typically draws 3,000 or more delegates. The Parent Body, Auxiliaries, Boards and Ministries of the Convention convene to conduct business and participate in worship services, fellowship and community service and evangelism activities; and,

**WHEREAS**, Alvin has served more than 40 years in a variety of roles: teacher, coach, and athletic director in Alabama High Schools; and,

**WHEREAS**, Alvin is a veteran basketball coach at Phillips High School and later Carver in Birmingham. He was the longest tenured coach in the Birmingham City Schools and served as head basketball coach from 1974-2013. He won more than 600 games with four appearances in the Final 48; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Carver and Alcorn (Mississippi) State graduate saw hundreds of his student-athletes receive scholarships in basketball, football and track. He coached in the Alabama North-South All-Star Game twice (1975 and 2003) and was named Class 5A Coach of the Year in 1993; and,
