THE HEAVY RESCUE TEAM**

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into on this the 9th day of January, 2014, by and between the CITY OF HUNTSVILLE, ALABAMA, a municipal corporation in the State of Alabama, doing business as the HUNTSVILLE-MADISON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (“EMA”) and the CITY OF MADISON, a municipal corporation in the State of Alabama.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS EMA has received a grants accepted by the City of Huntsville by adoption of resolution #13-905 on November 7, 2013 in the amount of \$18,260.00 (3FIL) from the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency, said funds to be used to provide training and sustainment funding for Alabama Mutual Aid System teams for the grant year of 2013.

WHEREAS the Cooperative Agreement included in the grant provides that the funds are to be for the benefit of all the citizens of Madison County, Alabama;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, and for other good and valuable consideration hereinafter provided, the parties do hereby agree as follows:

1. The CITY OF MADISON shall use \$18,260.00 in funds provided by 3 FIL pursuant to this Agreement to equip train responders, as outlined in the attached budget detail worksheets (Attachment “A”), to respond incidents as may be required by a WMD (Weapons of Mass Destruction) event.

2. Invoices for the purchases of such training and equipment shall be furnished to the Director of the Huntsville-Madison County Emergency Management Agency on a monthly basis, so that EMA can reimburse The CITY OF MADISON for the purchases.

3. The CITY OF MADISON agrees to assist and cooperate with EMA in providing all documentation required by the Alabama Department of Homeland Security to ensure compliance with the terms and conditions of the above referenced Alabama Homeland Security Grant to the Huntsville-Madison County Emergency Management Agency.

4. The CITY OF MADISON shall complete all training under this agreement and submit all invoices therefore no later than the end of the grant period.

5. This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Alabama.

6. This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties and there are no other promises or conditions whether oral or written. This Agreement supersedes any prior written or oral agreements between the parties.

7. This Agreement may be modified or amended if the amendment is made in writing and is signed by both parties.

8. If any provision of this Agreement shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and enforceable. If a Court finds that any provision of the Agreement is invalid or unenforceable, but that by limiting such provision it would become valid and enforceable, then such provision shall be deemed to be written, construed, and enforced as so limited.

9. The failure of either party to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall not be construed as a waiver or limitation of that party's right to subsequently enforce and compel strict compliance with every provision of this Agreement.

10. This Agreement shall become effective upon its execution by all parties.

11. Nothing contained herein shall create a contractual relationship with, or any rights in favor of, any third party.
