WHEREAS, the City of Huntsville adopted a Bikeway Plan in 2008.

WHEREAS, the City of Huntsville would like to relocate a portion of denied access fencing along the north side of I-565, west of Redstone Arsenal railroad spur and Research Park Boulevard to construct a bike path to connect to Governors Drive West

WHEREAS, this connection would provide a safe pedestrian-bicycle corridor from the EUL development on Redstone Arsenal to Bridge Street without crossing Interstate 565 or Norfolk Southern Rail Line;
