Free Invasive Species ID & Control Workshop and Field Practicum

This workshop will focus on invasive species prevention, detection, monitoring, control and management issues. Homeowners and natural areas managers are invited.

Please wear long pants and layer for the weather. Gloves and long handled loppers, pruning saws, or other heavy duty pruning/cutting tools should be brought.

The Field Practicum will take place later that morning at Maple Hill Park which is east of Maple Hill Cemetery located at 1351 McClung Avenue SE, Huntsville, AL. 35801. Invasive species there include: Chinese Privet, Bush Honeysuckle, English Ivy and Nandina. Control of these species is similar to control of other non-native invasive species you may encounter in the Madison County area. Control and removal will be demonstrated.
