#### **AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into on this the <a href="https://linear.com/11th/">11th</a> day of <a href="https://doi.org/10.2013">April</a>, 2013, by and between the HUNTSVILLE-MADISON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (hereinafter "EMA"), the CITY OF HUNTSVILLE, ALABAMA, a municipal corporation in the State of Alabama, (hereinafter "City") and the CENTRAL VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT (hereinafter "CENTRAL VFD").

WHEREAS, EMA has entered into the following grants or cooperative Agreements in furtherance of preparing emergency services to respond to acts of terrorism and other emergencies that threaten the public's safety and to enhance the capacity for emergency services within the State of Alabama:

A grant having been made to the Huntsville-Madison County EMA as approved by City of Huntsville, adopted April 11, 2013 for \$15,426.00 (0 MRS) to be used to support response efforts throughout the North Alabama region; and

**WHEREAS** EMA wishes to distribute \$15,426.00 (0 MRS) of said funds to CENTRAL VFD for its preparation for response to acts of terrorism.

#### WITNESSETH

**NOW THEREFORE,** for and in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, and for other good and valuable consideration hereinafter provided, the parties do hereby agree as follows:

- 1. EMA and the City agree to pay CENTRAL VFD a total of \$15,426.00 from 0 MRS contingent upon EMA and the City receiving the funds for such award from the Alabama Department of Homeland Security and CENTRAL VFD performing its obligations under this Agreement.
- 2. CENTRAL VFD shall use the said funds to provide equipment for responders within their department.
- 3. Title to any equipment purchased shall revert to EMA if CENTRAL VFD ceases to use said equipment for the purposes detailed in this Agreement.
- 4. CENTRAL VFD agrees to assist and cooperate with EMA in providing all documentation required by the Alabama Department of Homeland Security to ensure compliance with the terms and conditions of the above referenced contract between the Alabama Department of Homeland Security and EMA.
- 5. CENTRAL VFD shall complete all expenditures under this agreement and submit all invoices therefore no later than the ending date(s) of the grant, including extensions and submit all invoices to the Director of EMA for reimbursement.
- 6. CENTRAL VFD shall be solely responsible for payment of all state, federal, and local taxes in connection with payments made by EMA and the City pursuant to this Agreement.
- 7. Unless self-insured, CENTRAL VFD is obligated to obtain sufficient liability insurance coverage (as well as worker's compensation coverage, if required by law) for the benefit of its agents and/or employees. CENTRAL VFD waives any and all rights to recovery from the City and EMA for any injuries that CENTRAL VFD (and/or its agents and/or employees) may sustain while performing services under the above referenced grant and/or this Agreement.
- 8. CENTRAL VFD, to the fullest extent permitted by law, shall indemnify and hold harmless EMA and the City of Huntsville, their elected and appointed officials, employees, and agents against all claims, damages, losses, and expenses, including but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or resulting from any acts performed by any employee or agent employed by Madison County's program, including but not limited to (1) any claim for injury and/or death of such employee; and (2) any claim, attributable to personal injury, including bodily injury sickness, disease or death, or to injury to or destruction of tangible property, including loss of use resulting therefrom which is caused by any act or omission of such employee or agent.
- 9. This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Alabama.
